



### **Crinan Classics Environment Policy**

Crinan Classics recognises that virtually all activities have some impact on the environment.

It is our aim to minimise those impacts whilst ensuring we run the best possible event. We have worked with The Green Blue, the environment programme for the boating sector, to create our own environmental policy which frames our commitment to minimising our impact and improving our environmental performance.

Crinan Classics Management Committee commit to:

- Monitoring the environmental impacts of our business, specifically how much waste we produce so we can target improvements for next year.
- Encouraging all employees to address their environmental responsibilities within the framework of their normal work.
- Encouraging all event participants to follow environmental best practice.

Specifically this means we will:

- Minimise pollution from sea toilets. Crinan Classics will ensure that there are sufficient toilet facilities ashore and encourage boaters to use these at all times.
- Maintain a tidy, litter free site during and after the event.
- Seek to minimise waste and encourage our suppliers to do the same.
- Develop appropriate emergency response plans for major pollution incidents.
- Use locally sourced, seasonal and organic produce as much as possible.
- Use fish from sustainable supplies.
- Use email rather than printed materials for communication and promotion.
- Minimise pollution and disturbance from boats ensuring boaters are aware of The Green Blue's Code of Conduct.
